Dynamics take place in the highlighted area

Queueing only when:

- ready to race
- driver buckled up
- car ready (no tire protection)

Track conditions are shown via signs

Slippery track (or something that should not be there)



Rehaviour on track

- Always listen to the officials
- React to shown flags
- Race speed only between start and finish line
- Time starts running when crossing the starting line and ends with crossing the finish line
- After crossing finish line, please slow down to walking speed immediately (including entry, exit, return lane)



Skidpad Procedure

- Start at 21:00 h
- 21:30 h flood lights turned on
- 2 drivers, 2 runs each
- Maximum of 1 driver is allowed to drive before 21:30 h
- Pay attention to track marshals
- Last car at starting line 23:00 h
- Be careful on the public road

- 15:00 18:00 h
- 2 drivers, 2 runs each



Endurance Procedure

- Course walk: 9:00 09:30 h

- Session II: 13:30 h End
- 1 try according to running order
- The handling of the running order, the sessions and out of order running will be described in the announcement of the running order
- Enter Driver Change area slowly! The time doesn't count to Endurance
- TSAC must be charged immediately after Endurance.
